
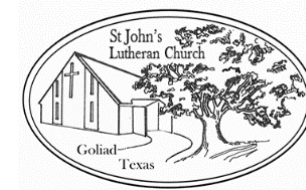

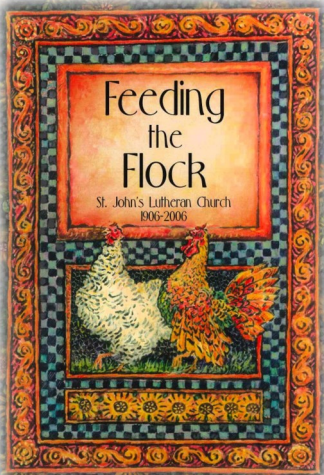
## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Potato Soup Submitted by Lavon Meyer

5 med. potatoes, peeled and diced	1 stalk celery, chopped
1 small onion, chopped	1 tsp. seasoned salt
1 tsp. celery salt	$\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. pepper
1 tsp. dried basil	4 cups water
2 tbs. dried parsley flakes	4 slices bacon
3 cubes bouillon	1 tbs. flour
	$1\frac{1}{2}$ cups milk

Combine first ten ingredients in large dutch oven. Bring to boil. Cover, reduce heat, simmer twenty minutes. Cook bacon in a skillet until crisp, remove bacon, reserving drippings. Crumble bacon and set aside. Add flour to drippings in skillet, stir until smooth. Gradually add milk, cooking over medium heat, stirring constantly until thick and bubbly. Gradually stir milk and bacon into potato mixture. Simmer, uncovered, for 45 minutes.
