
RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Potato Soup Submitted by Lavon Meyer

5 med. potatoes,	1 talk celery, chopped		
peeled and diced	1 tsp. seasoned salt		
1 small onion, chopped	¹ / ₄ tsp. pepper		
1 tsp. celery salt	4 cups water		
1 tsp. dried basil	4 slices bacon		
2 tbs. dried parsley flakes	1 tbs. flour		
3 cubes bouillon	$1^1/_2$ cups milk		

Combine first ten ingredients in large dutch oven. Bring to boil. Cover, reduce heat, simmer twenty minutes. Cook bacon in a skillet until crisp, remove bacon, reserving drippings. Crumble bacon and set aside. Add flour to drippings in skillet, stir until smooth. Gradually add milk, cooking over medium heat, stirring constantly until thick and bubbly. Gradually stir milk and bacon into potato mixture. Simmer, uncovered, for 45 minutes.
